We share a vision of bringing together everyone who is involved in compression therapy; from wearers of compression and their families and carers, healthcare professionals ... and manufacturers ...

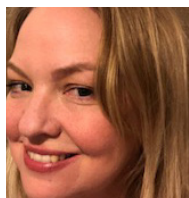
